

Apple Festival Art & Photography Show

The annual Apple Festival Art & Photography show will take place in the library's newly-acquired building, at 87 E. Spring St., on the following dates:

- Friday, October 6: 11:00am-6:00pm
- Saturday, October 7: 9:00am-3:00pm

Entries will be accepted Thursday, October 5, from 2:30pm-8:00pm.

This show is sponsored and made possible by the *Friends of the Library*.

Judging

Judging will take place prior to the show, the morning of Friday, October 6. The panel of judges will collectively judge each category. Ribbons will be given to the best of show, 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place. These will be distributed between the age groups and divisions, listed below.

Admission Rules

- Works must be original and produced by entrant. This excludes art teachers who submit on behalf of a class; however, the teacher must pay for and label each work separately.
- All entrants must sign a liability waiver stating that the Library or Friends of the Library are not responsible for any damages or discrepancies to entries.
- Students in grades 9-12 may enter art into the adult category if they wish.
- Student entries must be individually mounted. Frames are not allowed on student entries. Adult entries must be wired and ready to hang on the peg board.
- For every entry, students will pay a \$1 entry fee and adults will pay a \$2 entry fee. High school students entering into the adult category will pay \$1.
- Student entries will be divided into three groups. **Grades K-5** will be in a group by themselves. **Grades 6-8** will be in a group by themselves. **Grades 9-12** will be in a group by themselves. Any age group beyond that will enter into the **Adult** group. This only applies to the **Art** division. Photography entries will not be divided by age group.
- Entries from prior years may not be submitted again.

Divisions & Subdivisions

- **Drawing**—Drawings will be placed in the Art division. Drawings include pictures made with a pencil / pen, or any monochromatic medium. Maximum size for drawing entries is 18" x 24".
- **Painting**—Paintings will be placed in the Art division. Paintings include pictures made with any colored medium. Entries done in oil pastel / colored pencil may be submitted as either a painting or drawing. Maximum size for painting entries is 18" x 24".
- **Print-Making**—Prints will be placed in the Art division. Prints include pictures printed in ink by specially designed blocks or plates. Maximum size for print-making entries is 18" x 24".
- **Three-Dimensional**—3D entries will be placed in the Art division. These works can include ceramics, sculptures, jewelry, wood-making, etc.. Maximum size for 3D entries is 18" x 24" x 18".
- **Photography**—Photographs will be placed in the Photography division. Student and adult works will be placed together. Photos must be 8" x 10", matted not to exceed 11" x 14". The subdivisions are as follows:
