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Reading Room Display Policy

All display cases at the Bloomfield-Eastern Greene County Public Library are reserved for use of the library; however, a display area in the Reading Room in the Adult Area of the main branch is dedicated for the community to share art, various collections, and artifacts of local history or informative information. This display area is maintained by the Friends of the Library. The use of the display area is a privilege, not a right, and the Friends and the library reserve the right to deny the use of the display to any group or individual. Neither the library nor the Friends sponsor or endorse the views of any individual or group using the display area.

All individuals must agree to the following terms before items can be displayed.

1. Exhibits and displays are showcased for approximately one month.
2. Those choosing to exhibit displays are asked to remember that these spaces are public areas readily accessible to library patrons of all ages.
3. The library and the Friends reserve the right to pre-empt and schedule exhibit and display spaces for library events and promotions as it deems necessary and appropriate.
4. The library reserves the right to enhance the displays with library books and materials that will contribute to the presentation.
5. The Reading Room Display Area will not be used for:
 - a. Promotion of a for-profit business. There shall be no pricing information posted with the works.
 - b. Promotion of any activity or purpose that is in violation of local, state or federal laws, including copyright and public performance laws.
 - c. Promotion of individual political parties, candidates, or groups who wish to support or oppose political parties or candidates.
 - d. Display of material which is obscene, defamatory, invades an individual's privacy, discriminatory or incites violence.
6. The library and the Friends are not responsible for any loss, theft, or damage that may occur while works are on exhibit. All who choose to exhibit will be required to sign a form releasing the library and the Friends from all such liability.
