Art & Photography Show

The annual Apple Festival Art & Photography Show will take place in the Library Annex (87 E. Spring St.) on the following dates:

Friday, October 1-12:00 pm-6:00 pm
Saturday, October 2—12:00 pm-6:00 pm

Entries will be accepted the prior **Wednesday, September 29 – 5:00-7:30 pm**
Thursday, September 30 1200 pm-5:00 pm.

Community Interaction

This year, all entrants will have the opportunity to price for sale of their entries upon submission. The Art Show will give out the contact number of the seller, if asked.

Each entrant will also be given a prize just for entering the show. We encourage artists & photographers alike to enter solely with the intent of spreading the fine arts to the community.

Entry Rules

- Works must be original and produced by entrant. This excludes art teachers who submit on behalf of a class; however, the teacher must label each work individually.
- All entrants must sign a liability waiver upon entry stating that neither the library nor the Friends of the Library are responsible for any damages or discrepancies to entries.
- All entrants may frame their work in whatever way suits them; however, all framed entries **must be wired or ready to hang**. Entries without frames must be mounted, to prevent damage to the work upon hanging.
- Students will have **no entry fee**, and adults will have a **\$1 entry fee, per item**.
- All entries will be sorted and displayed by division and subdivision, respectively. The age or grade of each entrant will no longer determine where their work is displayed.
- All entries must be labelled with the entrant's name (and grade, if student), the division and subdivision of the entry, and the date it was completed. Labels may be placed anywhere on the work.
- Entries submitted to previous art shows may not be submitted again.

Two Dimensional Art

- **Drawing**—Drawings will include works made with a pencil, colored pencil, pen, charcoal, or any other non-liquid medium. Fixative spray is recommended for works done with charcoal or other finely ground media.
- **Painting**—Paintings will include works made with paint, watercolor, oil pastel, or any other liquid-based medium. Please ensure all paintings are dried upon submission.
- **Mixed Media**—Mixed media pieces include pictures made with any special material or method that wouldn't be included in the previous subdivisions. Examples include, but aren't limited to, scrapbook art, ink prints, wood burning, and any work consisting of various media.

Maximum size for all two-dimensional art entries is 18" x 24".

Labels for all two-dimensional art entries may be placed on the front or the back side.

Three Dimensional Art

Three-dimensional art will not be sorted into subdivisions, and will be displayed as one group. These works can include ceramics, sculptures, jewelry, wood, etc.

Maximum size for all three-dimensional art entries is 18" x 24" x 18".

Labels for all three-dimensional art entries may be placed anywhere on the work.

Photography

Photographs will be sorted and displayed by the list of subdivisions below. The subdivision of each photography entry will be determined by the entrant before or upon submission.

Labels for all photography entries may be placed on the front or the back side.
