

## Library Parking Policy

---

The Bloomfield-Eastern Greene County Public Library offers plentiful parking to meet the needs of those using the library or its services. Parking is available in the large, paved lot at the corner of Mechanic/Washington Street. Overflow parking in the gravel lot next to the alleyway, or the unpaved lot adjacent to it is reserved for library annex use or large library programs. Drive up parking near the annex is also reserved for annex use only. Parking at the Eastern Branch Library is available directly next to the building.

We love to see the downtown area of Bloomfield be used and taken advantage of, and for that reason community members are allowed to park in the library lots for non-library business for short orders of business – i.e. running a quick errand, dropping off or picking up something at the court house, picking up something to eat. However, leaving a vehicle in one of the library lots all day while at work, or while not conducting library-related business for an extended period will lead to your vehicle being towed at your own expense. For purposes of this policy, an extended period is defined as any amount of time greater than one hour.

Parking will be enforced in the library lots 9:30am-5pm Monday-Friday. After hours loitering should not occur, but community members are welcome to use our WiFi that is open 24 hours/day from the library parking lots.
