The Bloomfield-Eastern Greene County Public Library follows the policy of the Evergreen Indiana consortium that states that no refunds of fees will be given (Evergreen Indiana Circulation Policy, page 5). When a patron is charged for a lost or damaged book, and the patron has paid for the item, the item then belongs to the patron. If the library still has the item, or the item is accidentally returned, they will attempt to notify the patron to pick it up. After one year, any items still at the library will be considered donations.
