Video Checkout for Minors

The Bloomfield-Eastern Greene County Public Library follows the recommended guidelines of the Motion Picture Association of America (MPAA) to determine that "R" rated movies are inappropriate for minors. Juvenile card holders (those under eighteen years of age) may not borrow "R" rated materials. All other videos/DVD's will be available for checkout by the card holder. Juvenile card holders should be marked as "Resident Limited Access" (or "Nonresident Limited Access" when appropriate) in their profile. Once the patron reaches the age of eighteen, their profile should be changed to "Resident" (or "Nonresident") and check out of all videos/DVD's will become acceptable.

Parents of children under eighteen years of age may give a verbal request to the librarian that would exclude their child card holder of checking out any DVD from the library. If this occurs, the librarian should create an alert on the child's account.
